## How do I apply?

Speak to your IPO to obtain an application form or write to the Centre to have one mailed to you. Please note that only one application is required for both facilities.

## What happens after I apply?

Upon receiving your application, you can expect to be put on the visitor list for an interview. Visits are scheduled approximately every 8 weeks. All applicants who apply for Day Parole or are designated for Statutory Release with Residency (SRR) by CSC/PBC are reviewed by our Community Assessment Team for acceptance.

## What improves my chances of being accepted?

- Apply as early as possible to be seen by the CRF representative
- Demonstrate a consistent & positive attitude
- Complete required programs
- Follow correctional plan
